Deposit Account

Source of Funds:	Private contributions and similar funds made to The University Foundation at Sacramento State for support of this endowment.
Purpose / Use of Fund:	To honor the memory of Professor Robert Tice by providing support for the graduate programs of the Department of Speech and Pathology. This Endowment fund shall be invested in accordance with The University Foundation at Sacramento State policy. Direct expenditures from this fund are not authorized; the principal must remain intact.
<i>Distribution of</i>	Investment earnings shall be retained by the Endowment until the Endowment's balance reaches \$10,000.00.
Investment Earnings:	Once the Endowment has reached the minimum balance of \$10,000.00, all of the investment earnings allowed by The University Foundation at Sacramento State policy shall be deposited into the Robert Tice, Ph.D. Speech Pathology and Audiology Expenditure Account #X04180.

Expenditure Account

Source of Funds:	All of the earned interest allowed by The University Foundation at Sacramento State policy to be allocated outside of the endowment from the <i>Robert Tice, Ph.D. Speech Pathology and Audiology Endowment</i> , Account #X01010, and private contributions made directly to this fund.
Purpose / Use of Fund:	For use at the discretion of the Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology in support of the graduate programs.
